General Updates:

Management Review - (closed session)

Action: POB members will send specific feedback to PwC by October 31.

IMB Report-

Recommendation 3: Special meeting of the IMB in early 2015.

Comments: It is important to be clear on the objective for this special meeting whether it is held in Pakistan or UAE.

Recommendation 4: WHO takes over management of Central Africa outbreak instead of the WHO African Regional Office.

Comments: Recommendation under consideration by WHO.

Recommendation 6: Add GAVI as a member to POB.

Comments: Not sure there is a lot of benefit to either GPEI or GAVI. They are very involved with IPV and has been a successful partnership.

Decision: Will not move forward with this recommendation

<u>Pakistan</u>

The POB recommends the Pakistan government establish a functional EOC and designate NDMA to lead on the polio program in Pakistan.

Decision: Send letter to Pakistan PM in the next 24 hours.

Dec 12 POB Meeting

Tom Frieden noted there is a possibility he might not be able to be there. He would call into or join by VTC for part of the meeting (especially on Pakistan).

Focus more on Pakistan and have participation from their government at the meeting especially from NDMA if possible.

Do not need 3 hours for GPEI Management Review. POB will come to consensus before the meeting on the recommendations.
