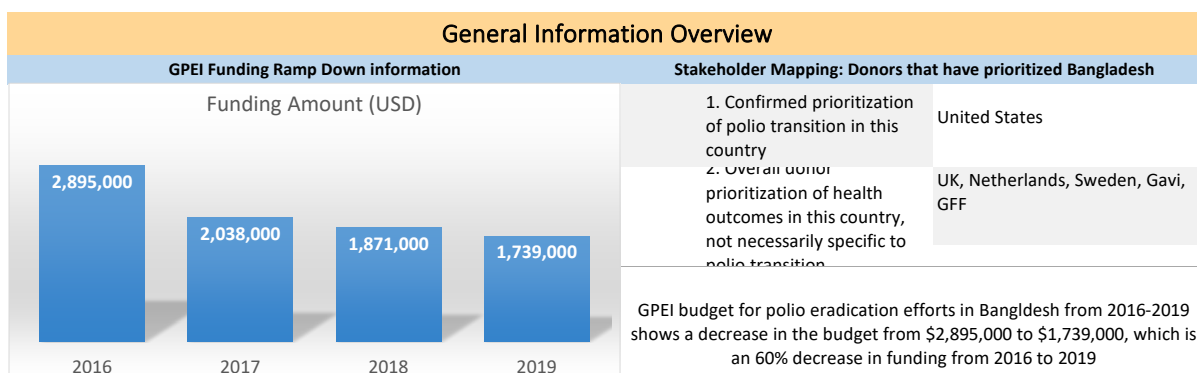


Bangladesh Asset Map (At-a-Glance)

Below is a summary of Bangladesh's polio programme resources and contributions made by the GPEI to it and other health initiatives in the country. It provides overview of the GPEI funding rampdown for Bangladesh from 2016 to 2019, and a stakeholder mapping exercise conducted in 2015 that identifies potential donors for Bangladesh. This page also provides a summary of all GPEI funded assets in the country supporting polio programme activities, including human resources and physical assets



Asset Mapping Data Overview As of August 2017

Since the polio eradication programme in Bangladesh has been highly integrated into the national EPI programme for many years, it is difficult to separate physical assets belonging to the polio programme from those belonging to or used by the EPI programme as a whole. However, if we restrict consideration to those physical assets specifically purchased with GPEI funds, then following is a reasonable summary:

WHO is also paying the rent for the field offices of 5 Divisional Coordinators @ an average of BDT 180,000 per year (US\$2,250). The total annual cost for the 5 offices is therefore US\$11,250.
