## **EXPENDITURES 2019**

In 2019, total expenditures for the GPEI programme were US\$ 866 million, finishing the year approximately US\$ 76 million, or 8.1%, below budget (the second smallest underspend since 2013). Details of programme expenditure by agency, broken out by category, appear in the table below. The key drivers of the overall variance to budget were:

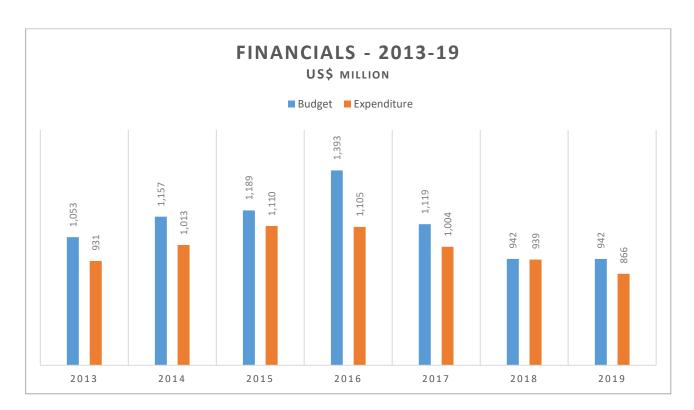
- Low implementation and access issues led to underspend in Supplementary Immunization Activities (SIAs) campaigns and Other Immunization Activities (Community-based Vaccination and Ongoing Social Mobilization).
- Outbreak response to vaccine-derived polio virus (VDPV) faced implementation challenges and delays in activities.
- Use of non-GPEI resources translated in additional underspend.
- Indirect costs, calculated based on direct expenditure, will increase the variance so long as there is a direct cost variance.
