Dear polio eradication supporter,

Thank you for your continued commitment as the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) launches its new <u>Polio Eradication Strategy 2022-2026</u>. On 10 June, global leaders, health workers and donors came together for a virtual launch event, "<u>Delivering on the Promise of a Polio-Free World</u>." Sharing live and pre-recorded content from GPEI partners, the launch featured updates on the rollout of novel oral polio vaccine type 2 (nOPV2), the story of a day in the life of a frontline health worker and remarks from programme leaders on how investing in the GPEI strengthens health systems everywhere. The event marked a moment of greater government ownership of the eradication effort and renewed support for a world without polio.
