<sup>2</sup> The pledge reflects the Gates Foundation's commitment to GPEI for 2026-2029. Of this amount, US\$ 100 million for 2026 was pledged in Berlin in 2022, and US\$ 300 million was pledged in Calgary in June 2025, when Rotary International and the Gates Foundation announced the extension of their partnership to end polio through 2029. Under this partnership, Rotary will continue to raise US\$ 50 million per year, with each dollar matched by two dollars from the Gates Foundation. This renewed agreement will provide up to US\$ 450 million in support of GPEI. The pledge includes US\$ 800 million in new funding.

<sup>3</sup> Includes Germany's 2025 contribution of €30 million and 2026 pledge of €23.2 million.

<sup>4</sup> Includes Japan's 2025 contribution to support polio eradication efforts in Afghanistan and Pakistan. Japan is a long-standing supporter of GPEI, providing annual contributions and committing more than US\$ 23 million since 2022.

<sup>5</sup> Includes Luxembourg's €2.88 million pledge to GPEI for 2025-2028.

<sup>6</sup> The Government of Pakistan's national polio program for 2026-2029 is estimated at US\$ 639.7 million, with a direct Government contribution of US\$ 154.3 million.
